BT : **PREHISTORIC**

SN : From the introduction of bronze working technology around 2,200 years BC to the beginning of iron working technology around 700 years BC.

EARLY MEDIEVAL

SN : From the abandonment of Britain by the Roman legions in 410AD to the establishment of Norman control over large parts of Wales in 1086.

GENERAL

USE : **NOT APPLICABLE**

IRON AGE

BT : **PREHISTORIC**

SN : From the introduction of iron working technology around 700 years BC to the invasion of Britain by Rome in 43AD.

MEDIEVAL

SN : From the establishment of Norman control over large parts of Wales in 1086 to the Act of Union between England and Wales in 1536.

MESOLITHIC

BT : **PREHISTORIC**

SN : The 'Middle Stone Age' from the end of the last Ice Age around 8,500 years BC ago to the introduction of farming in the British Isles around 4,000 years BC. 10000 - 4400BC

MODERN

SN : The twentieth and twenty-first century.

MULTIPERIOD

SN : Should be used where the date or use if the feature spans more than one period.

NEOLITHIC

BT : **PREHISTORIC**

SN : The 'New Stone Age' from the introduction of farming in the British Isles to the introduction of metal technology in the Bronze Age around 2,200 years BC.

NOT APPLICABLE

UF : *GENERAL*

SN : Where the period of the record is not significant. This value is often used for topographic or natural features.

PALAEOLITHIC

BT : **PREHISTORIC**

SN : The 'Old Stone Age' from the earliest appearance of man in the British Isles to the end of the last Ice Age around 8,500 years BC.

PLEISTOCENE

BT : **PREHISTORIC**

SN : The period that covers the span of the Palaeolithic periods (Lower, Middle, Early Upper, Late Upper and Final) that were commonly known as the Old Stone Age.

POST MEDIEVAL

SN : From the Act of Union between England and Wales in 1536 to the end of the nineteenth century.

SN : All periods up to the invasion of Britain by the Romans in 43AD.

SN : From the invasion of Britain by the Romans in 43AD to its abandonment by the legions in 410AD.

UNKNOWN

SN : Where the period of the monument cannot be established.
